Sisters and Brothers,

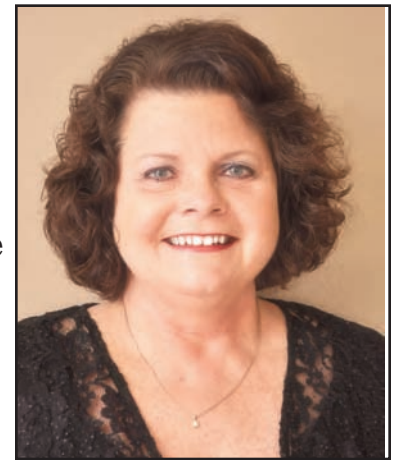
