- Members of all religions may belong to the Order of Eastern Star. We only require a belief in a Supreme Being.
- After your initiation into our Order during a regular meeting, you may attend as your time permits. There is no “required” obligation of time.
- There is no mandatory memory work except the means of making yourself known if you wish to visit a Chapter or if you become an officer. A short proficiency examination is strictly voluntary, but encouraged.
- Members are taught an allegiance to preserve the good order of their country. We strongly support the government of the United States.



Our symbol is the Star of Bethlehem with the five-pointed star as our accepted symbol. Our lessons of brotherly love, relief, and truth are portrayed through biblical heroines in our initiation ceremony. Business meetings are conducted with an open Bible on the altar and the flag of our country displayed.

Membership-Eligibility

Affiliated Master Mason in good standing and any female relatives who are related by birth, marriage or adoption to affiliated Master Masons in good standing, or if deceased were in good standing at the time of their death, as well as members—either active for three (3) years or majority—of the International Order of Rainbow for Girls or in Job's Daughters International, and women sponsored by a Sister or Brother who are members of the Order and each of whom having attained the age of eighteen (18) years, are eligible to membership in the Order of the Eastern Star.

How Does One Belong?

Those desiring membership must petition to do so. Petitions are carefully read, eligibility investigated and election to membership must be by unanimous vote. The Order strives to select persons of mental, moral and spiritual quality who will work together in harmony to perform its objectives:

- Be of good moral character
- Believe in a supreme being
- Be at least 18 years old
- Believe in the laws of the United States
- Be willing to assume the obligation of the Order and participate in the ceremony of initiation
- Not be convicted of a felony under the laws of any state in the United States
- Meet eligibility requirements.

Meaning of Membership

The members of the Order of the Eastern Star are dedicated women and men who sincerely reflect the spirit of fraternal love and the desire to work together for good. It gives them the opportunity to give a part of their time to many projects that benefit mankind.
